PROPOSITION 100

PERMANENT BASE ADJUSTMENT

Proposal submitted by Town Council of Quartzsite, AZ.

A resolution proposing a permanent adjustment to the state-imposed base limitation for the Town of Quartzsite, AZ.

Pursuant to the Arizona State Constitution, the Town of Quartzsite seeks voter approval to permanently adjust the expenditure base of the Town as determined by the Economic Estimates Commission. The Town of Quartzsite seeks an adjustment of \$8,465,210.00.

A "YES" vote shall have the effect of allowing the Town to adjust its base expenditure limit.

A "NO" vote shall have the effect of not allowing the Town to adjust its base expenditure limit and to require expenditures of the Town to be limited by the state-imposed expenditure limit.
